- 1. Human `omic data collected about or maintained on more than 1,000 U.S. persons, or, in the case of human genomic data, more than 100 U.S. persons. Human `omic data includes genomic data, epigenomic data, proteomic data, and transcriptomic data;
- 2. Biometric identifiers on more than 1,000 U.S. persons;
- 3. Precise geolocation data on more than 1,000 U.S. devices;
- 4. Personal health data on more than 10,000 U.S. persons;
- 5. Personal financial data on more than 10,000 U.S. persons; or
- 6. Personal identifiers on more than 100,000 U.S. persons. Personal identifiers include, but are not limited to social security numbers, driver's license numbers, passport numbers, account usernames, and account passwords. This does not include publicly available information (ex: first and last name).
